Lake Nahuel Huapi, Cerro Catedral and the Circuito Chico: hut-to-hut trekking, skiing, kayaking, chocolate and the most classic Argentine Patagonia.

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Nature

Bariloche looks out over Lake Nahuel Huapi, in the heart of Argentina's oldest national park: coihue and arrayán forests, snow-capped peaks and dozens of lakes. To the west, Cerro Tronador and its glaciers; to the south, the Circuito Chico and the Llao Llao peninsula.



Activities

- Hut-to-hut trekking: Frey, Otto Meiling, Laguna Negra, Jakob
- Skiing and snowboarding at Cerro Catedral, the largest resort in South America
- Kayaking and boat trips on Nahuel Huapi, Victoria Island and the Arrayanes forest
- Mountain biking and horseback riding on the Circuito Chico, rafting on the Manso river
- Chocolate, craft beer and Patagonian lamb

When to go

December to March for trekking and lakes; April and May for autumn; June to September for skiing; October and November for fewer people.

How to get there

Bariloche airport (BRC) is 15 km away, with frequent flights from Buenos Aires (2 hours) and other cities. Buses from Buenos Aires (20 to 22 hours) and from Chile via Osorno and the Cardenal Samoré pass (6 to 7 hours from Puerto Varas). The Circuito Chico and Cerro Catedral are reached by city bus.

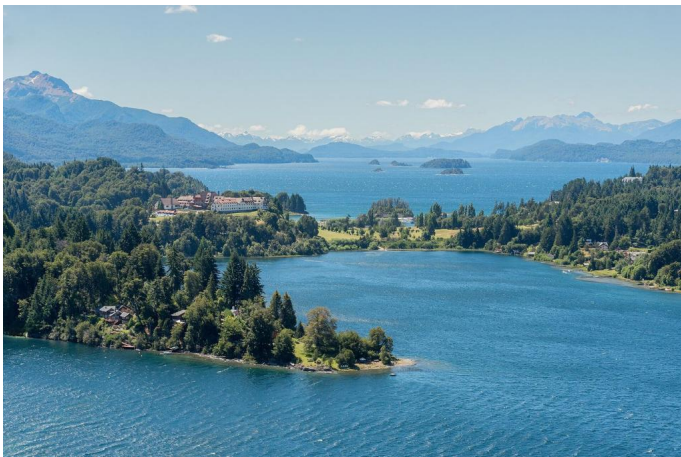

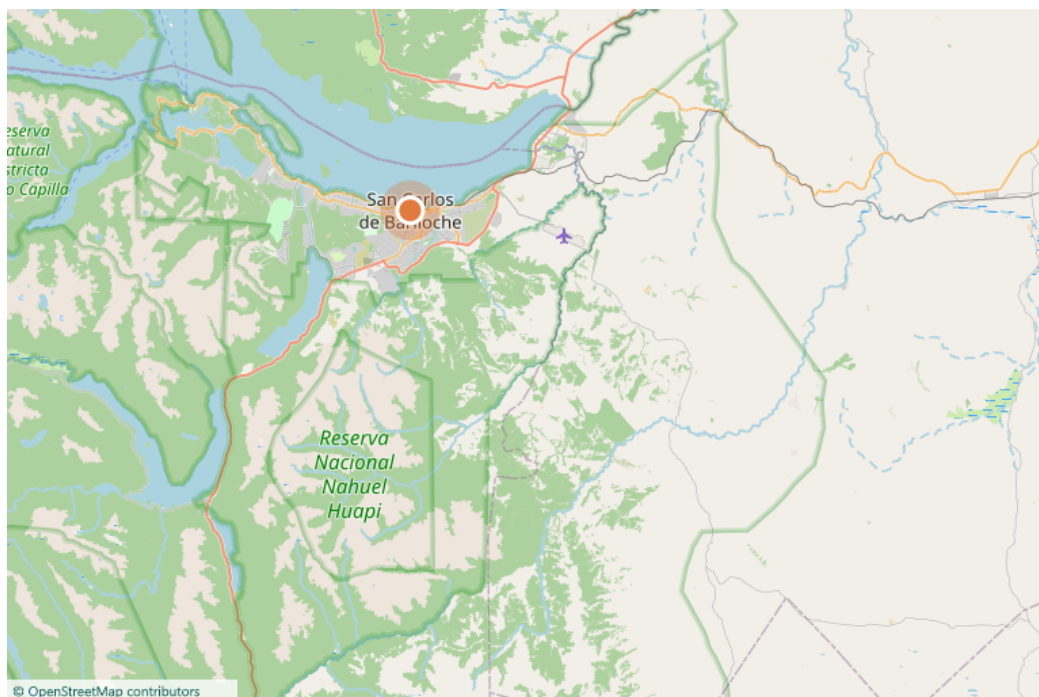
